- 1. The committee found that there is no need at this time to develop new/formal criteria for evaluating mission requests from commercial or non-science missions.
- 2. The committee agreed it would be useful for the MSC to periodically follow-up with missions to update their tracking needs and assess the value of continued ILRS support.
